

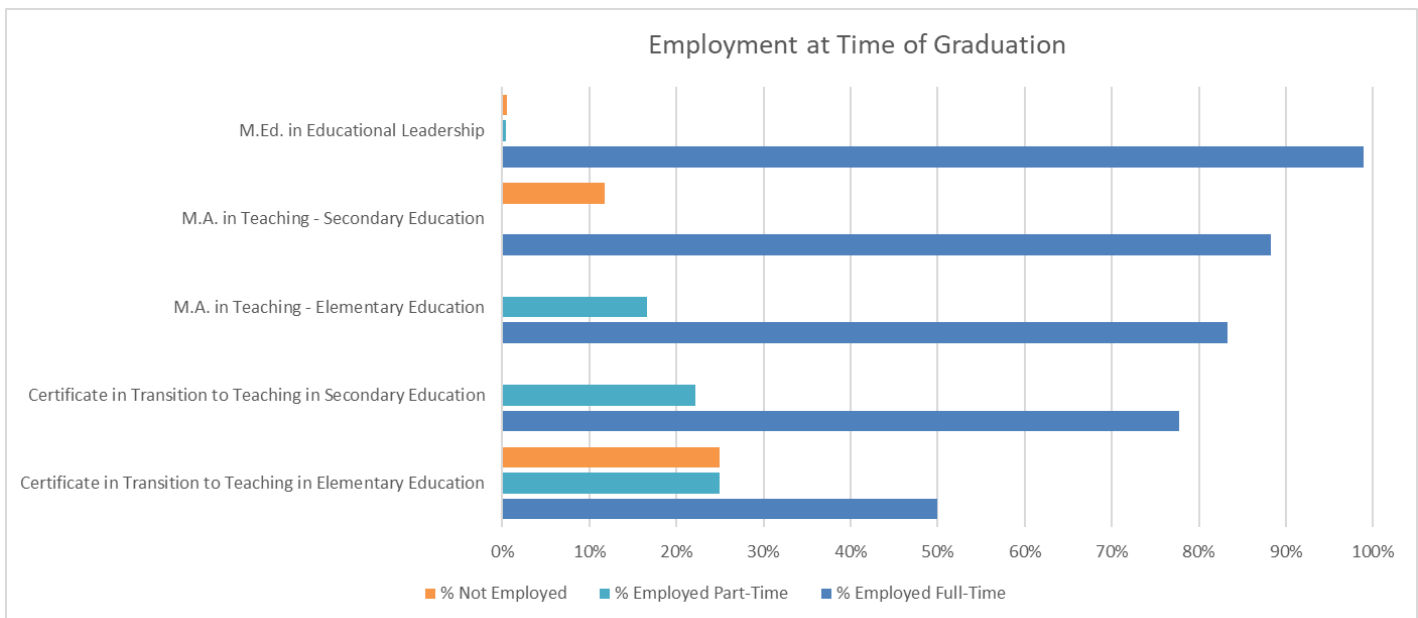
## American College of Education (ACE) Graduating Cohort Employment

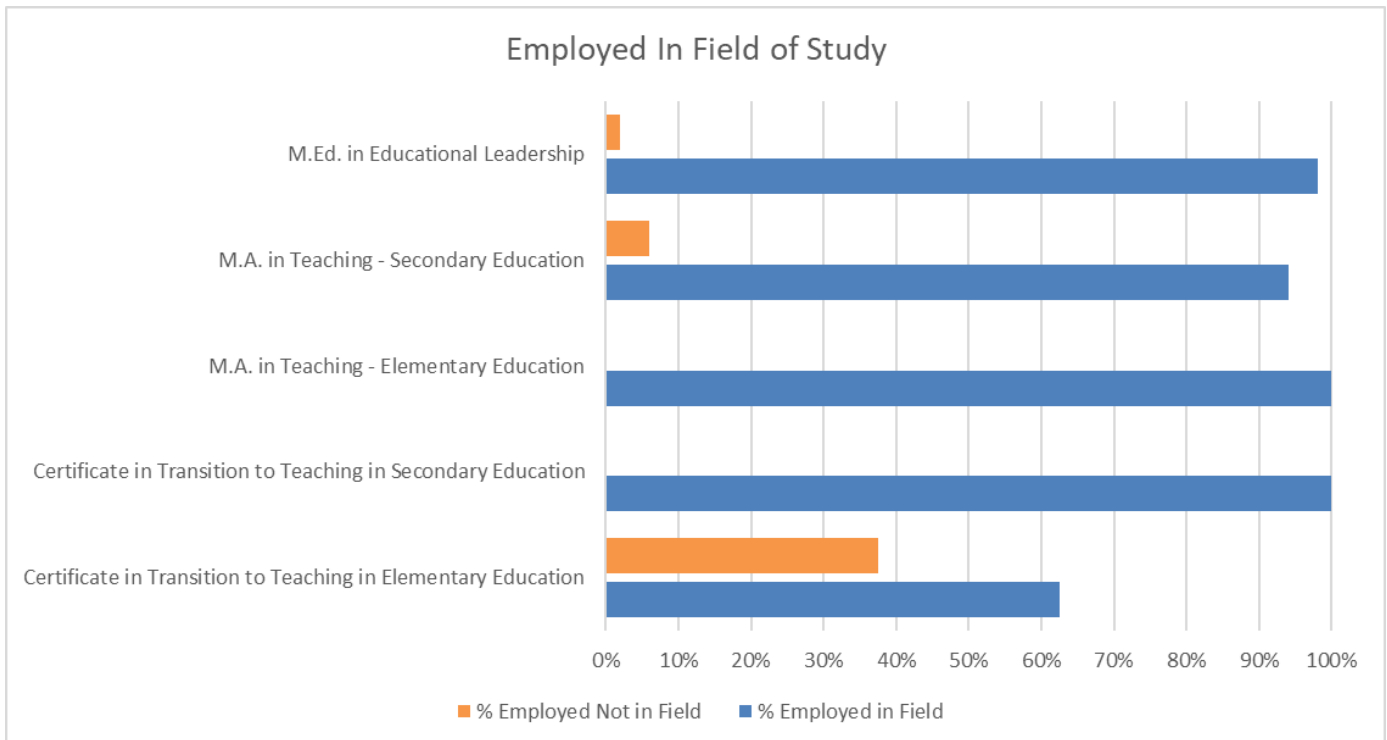
