

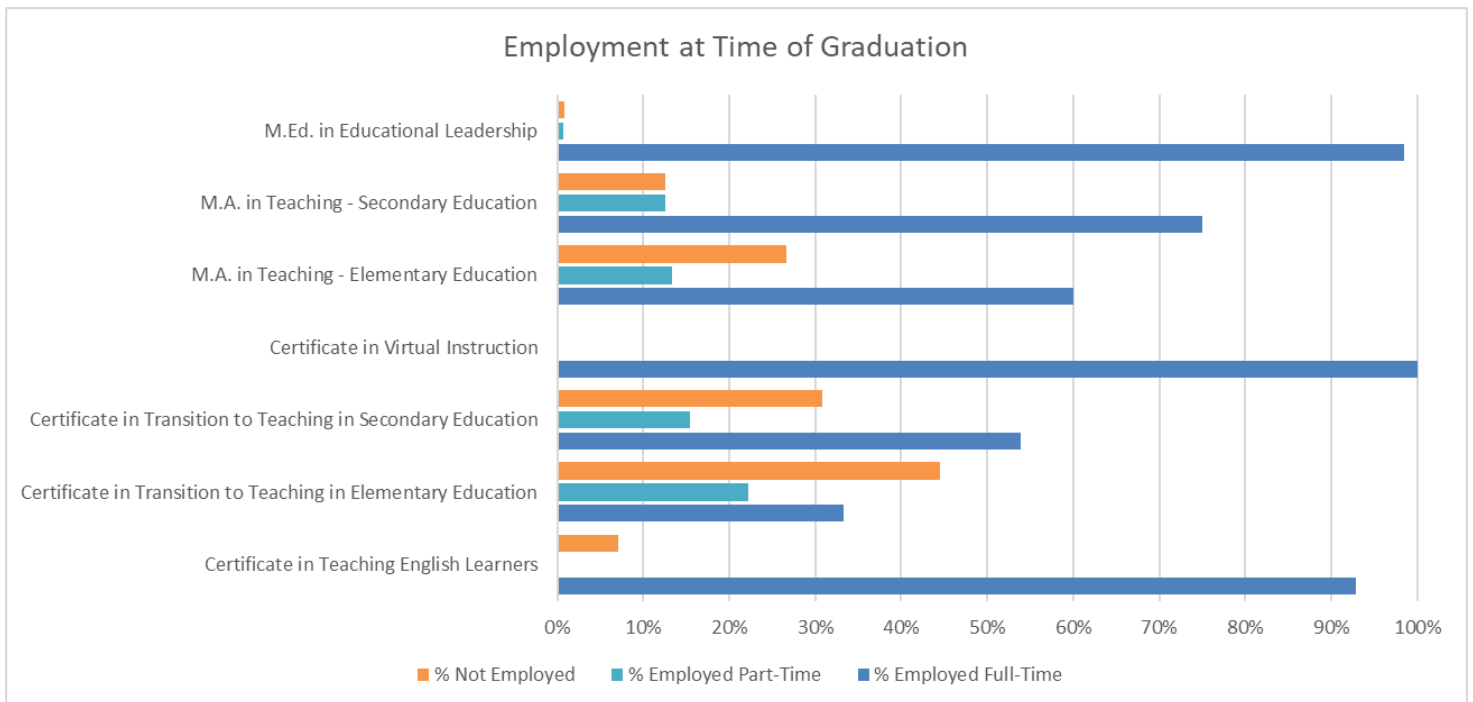
American College of Education (ACE) Graduating Cohort Employment

ACE tracks the number and percentage of completers that are employed after graduation both in and out of field.

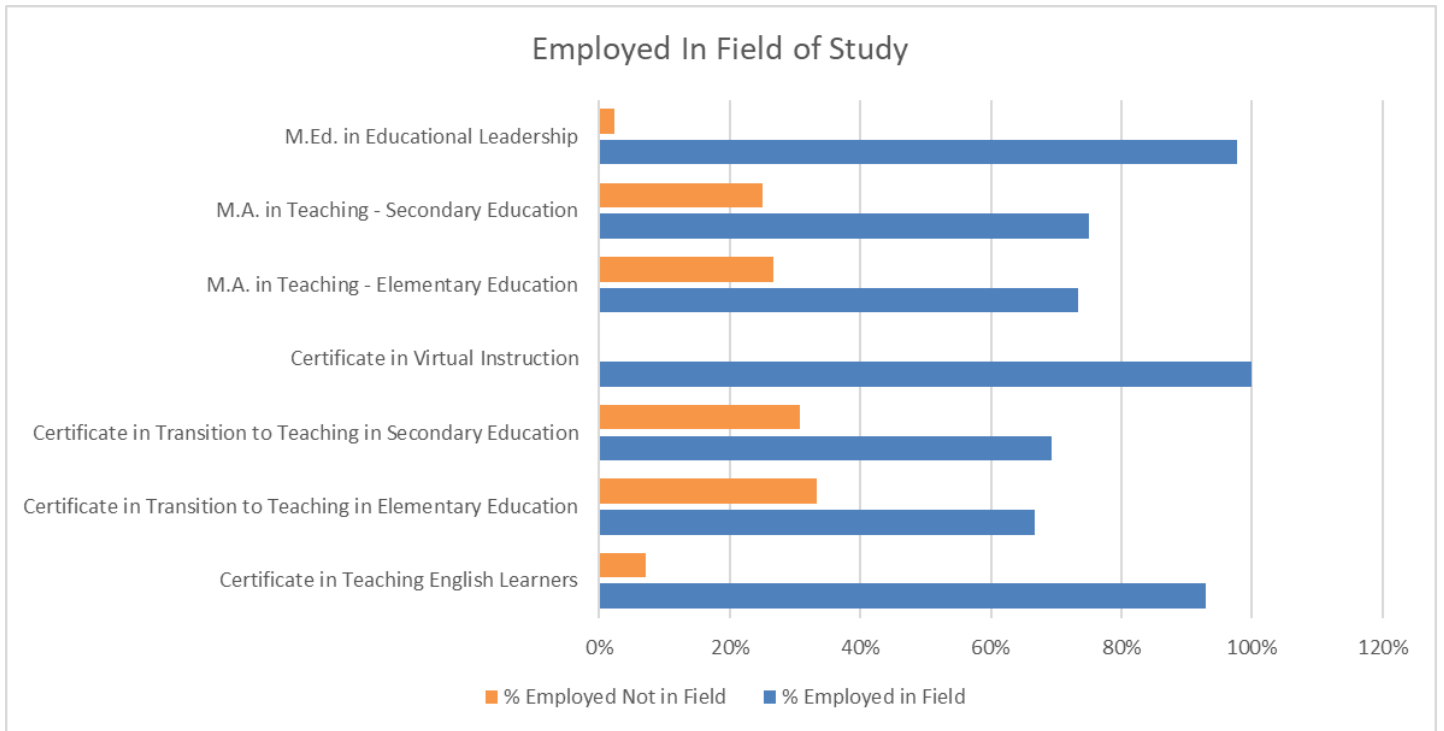
