

ABILITY OF COMPLETERS TO BE HIRED IN POSITIONS FOR WHICH THEY HAVE BEEN PREPARED

(Initial and Advanced Programs)

The employability of ACE completers, either initial or advanced programs, is gauged partly by their success rates in state-mandated licensure exams. Passing these exams is a prerequisite for obtaining licensure and securing employment in education. Presented below is the latest licensure exam data from states where the American College of Education (ACE) offers approved educator preparation programs. These figures underscore the effectiveness of ACE in preparing graduates for their intended roles. Furthermore, graduates also provide self-reported employment information within their qualified school settings. All data pertains to the 2022-2023 academic year.
